

Dr. Campos Schweitzer is a full-time equine surgeon at the Grosbois Equine Clinic in France. A graduate of the University of Hanover (2017) and Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Surgeons (2024), Dr. Schweitzer specializes in upper airway pathologies and the development of novel 3D-printed orthopedic implants. Their research includes innovative approaches to laryngeal reinnervation, with several publications in leading veterinary journals and a forthcoming study slated for 2025. Their clinical experience spans multiple equine referral hospitals across Europe.



SAFIA BARAKZAI

Dr. Barakzai BVSc MSc DESTS Dipl. ECVS FRCVS is an internationally recognised equine surgeon specialising in soft tissue surgery, particularly upper respiratory ("wind") disorders, dental and sinus surgery, and minimally invasive techniques. A Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Surgeons and RCVS-recognised specialist, she has over 80 peer-reviewed publications and has authored two textbooks. After training and working at the University of Edinburgh for over a decade, she founded Equine Surgical Referrals in 2017, providing mobile surgical services across the UK and abroad.



JUAN MUÑOZ

Dr. Muñoz, graduated from Complutense University of Madrid (2003), with advanced training including internships in Canada (London Equine Hospital) and France (Veterinary University of Lyon), where he completed a residency and earned the European College of Veterinary Surgeons diploma (2009). He holds a PhD focused on guttural pouch mycosis and has worked in both academic and private clinical settings. Currently a surgical team member at Hospital de Referencia la Equina in Manilva, Spain. Author of multiple publications and frequent speaker at national and international conferences. Specializes in upper respiratory tract disorders and in-station surgical techniques.
